



RAINSMART TERRAVAULT TREE ROOT PROTECTION MODULES ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS







Lay a large open Terravault plate (A) on a level surface.



Insert 5 small open access plates (B) placing the longer lugs into the small holes that are equally spaced on the plate. If you are looking to cap off one end then replace one end open access plate with a small closed Ellipse plate.




Lay another large Terravault plate (A) on to top of the small open access plates and align holes. If you are looking to block off a side then replace the large Terravault plate with a large closed Ellipse plate.



Turn the crate on its side so that an open face is pointing upwards and add another large Terravault plate (A). Tap into place. Now turn the crate upside down & add another large Terravault plate (A).



Tap each face with the mallet to ensure that all plates are firmly in position, then set the crate to one side.



As in step 1, lay a new large Terravault plate A down flat. Repeat step 2 above. If you are looking to block one end of the crate then as before replace the open access plate on one end with a small closed Ellipse plate.



Repeat steps 3 & 4 above (remember to use a large Ellipse plate if you are looking to block off one side) but this time leave the top and bottom open. Lower this crate (with one of the open faces pointing downwards) onto the first crate and fix in place.




Add the crates to your excavation with the open tops. Fill modules with nutrient-rich soil. You can then attach the final Ellipse large closed plates on top of the modules.








BIRDSEYE VIEW Terravault System - 12SQM - 36 crates laid in a 7 x 6 formation Terravault modules with capped top, side and end



The 12 SQM Terravault Tree Root protection system is comprised of 36 crates laid out 7 crates wide x 6 crates long. Each individual module should have a large Ellipse plate on top. All modules on the edge of the system are also to be capped using either the Large Ellipse Plates (for the sides) or Small Ellipse Plates (for the ends).



The hole for the tree rootball should be left open - 2 crates long x 3 crates wide (1.2m x 1.4m). Roots can then feed into the openings of the Terravault modules following the paths of least resistance.



All crates should be built and laid in the excavation without the top Large Ellipse Plate added (as per the image above). Modules should then be filled with nutrient-rich soil to act as a slow-release fertiliser continually feeding the root structure. Once this has been added, the top capped plates can then be attached.



You should place Terravault units tightly butt up against each other. You can connect modules together using cable ties. Cable ties are not structural, they are only used to hold the modules in place until backfill is added to the installation.
